Board of Education member, Christine Letchinger, has announced her resignation from the School Board effective April 8, 2015. She has served our District since 2013 in a variety of leadership capacities, most recently as Board Secretary. Christine had to resign for personal reasons. We appreciate her contribution to the Board of Education and to our District and wish her well in her future endeavors.

And so begins the process of appointing a new Board Member; Board Policy 2:70 and Illinois School Code specifically state that "if the vacancy occurs with less than 868 days remaining in the term, the person so appointed shall serve the remainder of the unexpired term, and no election to fill the vacancy shall be held". We have 45 days from the date of a resignation to accomplish this or the responsibility shifts to the Regional Superintendent of Schools.



Completed applications must be received at the District 65 office no later than 4 p.m. on Wednesday, April 29, 2015. Once applications have been reviewed by the Board of Education, it is anticipated that selected candidates will be interviewed shortly thereafter, with installation to the Board of Education by the end of May 2015. The timeline of specific dates is attached as well as available on our District website.

We are hoping to find a person whose talents, interests and experience will add to and complement those of the existing Board Members. Since only one person can be selected, we hope the process outlined above will give the Board a list of prospects for future community involvement in school matters and projects.
